Local risk-management business eBureau on Tuesday announced a new partnership with a debt collection software company.

It has partnered with a company called Roydan Enterprises, which offers debt collection software to collection agencies. The software is called "Bloodhound," according to a news release.

The trade is that eBureau will have access to more than 200 clients as Roydan clients will have access to eBureau's specialized systems that predict what customers are economically worth pursuing.

This is eBureau's second announcement regarding about a half-dozen such debt collection software company partnerships. The first was made in December.

St. Cloud-based eBureau has been growing, despite the recession. It plans to hire 10-15 people this year and added 20 last year, bringing its total employee count up to 60.

Also, such businesses as debt collection are big in an economy where people falter on their payments.
